EQUIPMENT:

counting tray spatula

mortar and pestle calibrated graduate(s) stirring rod amber storage bottle

labels

INGREDIENTS	QUANTITY		
Pyrazinamide 500 mg	20 tablets		
Simple Syrup	qs ad 100 mL		

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Triturate tablets to a fine powder
- 2. Add approximately 10 mL of Simple Syrup and stir until a smooth paste is formed.
- 3. Gradually add Simple Syrup.
- 4. Stir thoroughly after each addition.
- 5. Qs to final volume.
- 6. Transfer to an appropriate sized amber bottle and label.
