

# COMPOUNDING FORMULA

### TACROLIMUS ORAL SUSPENSION 1 MG/ML

Ingredient	Quantity
Tacrolimus 5 mg (Prograf® only)*	20 capsules
Sterile Water for Irrigation	15 mL
Ora Blend®	qs ad 100 mL

\* NOTE: The stability study was based on using Prograf® 5 mg capsules

#### **Equipment:**

- gloves and gownN-95 mask
- paper towel
- large plastic bag
- spatula
- plastic lined absorbent pad
  mortar and pestle
- calibrated graduate
- alcohol

### Storage:

- Room Temperature
- Protect from light

#### Stability:

• 90 days

For patients on tacrolimus suspension who have a transplant and live in:

- Nova Scotia; tacrolimus suspension dispensed by IWK pharmacy (High Cost Drug Program)
- PEI; tacrolimus suspension dispensed by Provincial Pharmacy

# Procedure (prepare in biological safety cabinet [BSC]:

- 1. Calibrate storage bottle with water and mark final volume (leave room in the bottle for shaking).
- 2. Protect the surface of the BSC with an absorbent drape cloth (or equivalent).
- 3. Place mortar and pestle in clear plastic bag. Empty capsules into mortar, add sterile water and triturate powder to a fine paste, *working in plastic bag* to prevent flying dust from tablets.
- 4. Add approximately 30 mL of Ora Blend® to the tacrolimus suspension in mortar and mix well. Remove mortar and pestle from plastic bag and transfer contents to stock bottle.
- 5. Rinse mortar with Ora Blend® a few times and transfer to stock bottle. Qs ad to final volume and shake well.
- 6. Wipe outer surface of stock bottle with 70% isopropyl alcohol and remove from the BSC. Label.
- 7. Wipe out mortar and pestle with paper towel to remove excess suspension.
- 8. Fold all disposable waste in the absorbent drape cloth and place in cytotoxic waste (sharps) container.
- 9. Clean the biological safety cabinet as per weekly procedure.
- 10. Dispose of personal protective equipment in the cytotoxic waste container.
- 11. Clean reusable supplies with soap and water. Rinse well with water and wipe dry.
- 12. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water.
