EQUIPMENT: counting tray mortar and pestle stirring rod labels spatula calibrated graduate(s) amber glass storage bottle

INGREDIENTS	QUANTITY		
Carvedilol 12.5 mg Sterile Water for Irrigation	10 tablets ~ 2 mL		
Ora Blend®	qs ad 100 mL		

PROCEDURE:

- 1. If coating on tablets is hard dissolve them in water for 10 minutes and then grind into a smooth paste.
- 2. Gradually add Ora Blend®. Stir after each addition.
- 3. Qs to final volume with Ora Blend® and mix thoroughly.
- 4. Transfer to an appropriately sized amber glass container.
- 5. Shake well and label.
