

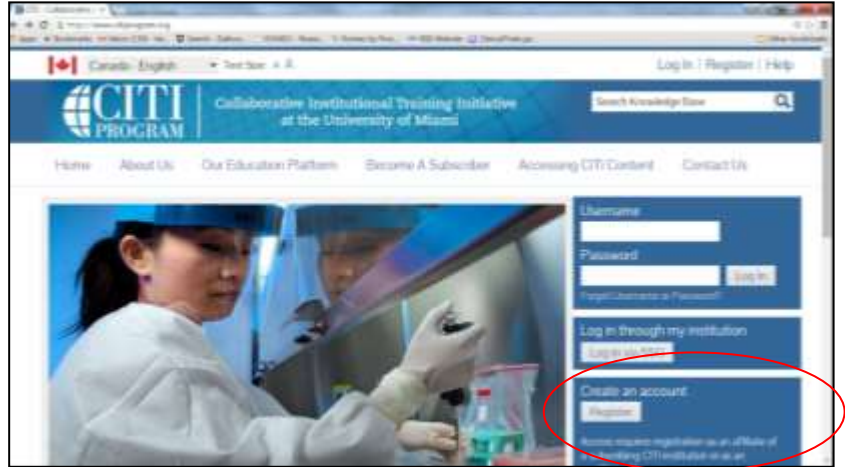
CITI Online Courses Now Available for IWK Researchers and Staff

In conjunction with our Network of Network (N2) membership, we are now able to offer the Collaborative Institutional Train Initiative (CITI) online training courses customized for Canadian researchers.

- Social & Behavioral Research
- Transportation of Dangerous Goods

Registration is free at www.citiprogram.org

The website is tested, verified and supported to work on: Internet Explorer 8, Chrome, Firefox or Safari, on XP and up, or Apple OS. Several older systems are functional but may no longer be supported. If you have questions about your operating system, further details are available from the Research Ethics office.



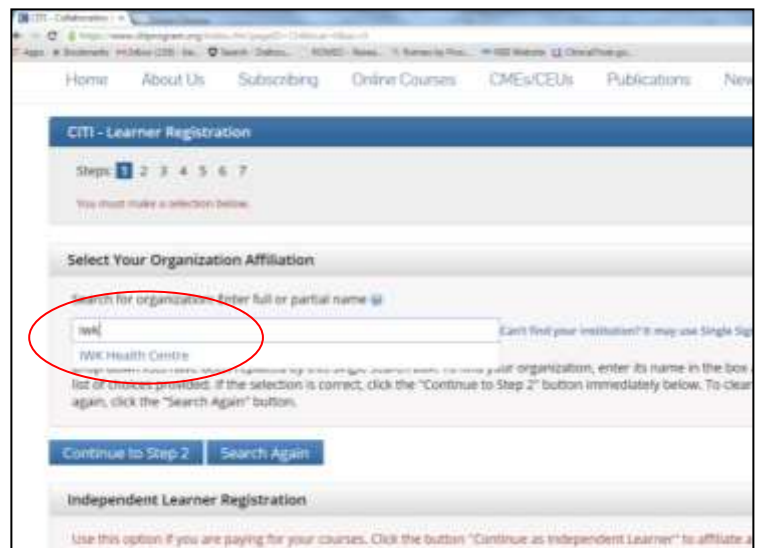
Courses are comprised of modules that may be completed over time. Completion of required modules with an average of 80% will provide a certificate of completion meeting regulatory requirements for training, for example, ICH-GCP or Health Canada Division 5.

The 7 step Registration process begins with identifying the Organization: Type *iwk* and select *IWK Health Centre*.

For each course selected, you are asked to identify yourself by “Group”:

- Investigator
- Research Staff or Trainee
- REB

REB members have several modules labeled as *Optional*, so members who are also researchers should select *Investigator* to ensure all modules apply to their certification score. Optional modules are available to all groups as *Supplemental Modules*.
