IWK Health and the Dalhousie Division of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery are seeking applicants who wish to pursue an academic career in Pediatric Otolaryngology. The successful fellowship trained candidate will join 3 full-time Pediatric Otolaryngologists surgeon to offer tertiary care pediatric otolaryngology services to the Maritime Provinces. Protected research time is available and encouraged.

IWK Health is the tertiary care pediatric teaching hospital affiliated with Dalhousie University and a centre for excellence in health care research. We provide quality care to women, children, youth, and families in the Maritimes and beyond. We are engaged in leading-edge research, works to promote healthy lifestyles for families, and supports education opportunities for health professionals and other learners. Services provided by IWK Health are delivered through three programs: Children's Health, Mental Health and Addictions and Women's and Newborn Health.

IWK Health provides core health services to 500,000 Halifax region residents (50% of the population of Nova Scotia) and tertiary and quaternary acute care services to residents of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and PEI, serving as the sole tertiary care pediatric centre to this population of approximately 2 million people. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority.
