Contact Coordinator

Contact the NSIPP coordinator using the information above. Let them know if you need funding for a new pump or just supplies. The coordinator will help you with the NSIPP process.

02



Access Support

Complete a self-assessment, see a primary care provider (family doctor or nurse practitioner), and get referred to a diabetes team and specialist to start the clinical eligibility process.

03



Connect with Diabetes Team

Meet with your diabetes team to see if an insulin pump is right for you. They will support your self-management learning and help you choose a pump.

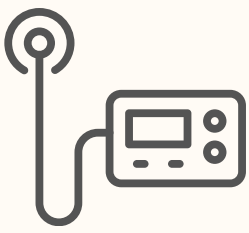

Connect with Specialist

Meet with your diabetes specialist to assess safety and receive medical care. They will sign forms and provide pump start orders.

05



Order Insulin Pump

Once you decide which pump is right for you, your start date, and who will complete your pump training, you can order your pump.

06



Start Insulin Pump

Complete training on how to use your new pump. Your diabetes team or a community industry clinician will start you on your insulin pump.

07



Plan Follow-up Care

Follow-up with your diabetes team within 2 weeks, and with your specialist as needed. Plan for regular care throughout the year.
