### IWK Learner Placement Page

**One Person One Record (OPOR)** is a clinical transformation initiative that will improve delivery of healthcare for patients across Nova Scotia with IWK Health and Nova Scotia Health.

Regardless of where a patient accesses care, care teams will have real time, comprehensive access to their health information, and to standardized, best care practices.

All students that have placements with IWK Health from December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025, onwards, and require access to patient documentation will need OPOR-CIS training. Training information will be sent to their school email within 30 days of the placement start date. Training must be completed at least 10 days prior to the placement start date to ensure timely access to the CIS.
