### OPOR-CIS Student Training

The OPOR Education and Learning team recognizes the challenges regarding accessibility to OPOR-CIS training. To enhance the delivery of student training and improve access, all online OPOR-CIS student courses will now be available through guest access on the [Learning Management System \(LMS\)](#). This change ensures that students can complete the required training regardless of active directory access, supporting timely completion of pre-placement requirements. Students who already have active directory logins are encouraged to continue accessing their training through their individual accounts.

With this improvement in training accessibility, **all academic institutions will be accountable for ensuring that students have completed the required training modules prior to placement.** This shift aligns with existing pre-placement procedures used at IWK Health and Nova Scotia Health.

Guest access for OPOR-CIS training will be effective immediately. Academic partners and students are reminded to ensure that all pre-placement requirements are met. All students are accountable to keep a record of their training completion. The OPOR team will continue to process student access requests promptly to support a positive student learning experience.

Please refer to the revised **OPOR-CIS Student Training Instructions**, which outlines the updated access process for training modules. Students must complete training at least 10 business days prior to the placement start date.

**Important Note:** An active directory account and OPOR-CIS application access requests are still required for any student who will be using these applications. Please continue to submit IT access requests as previously directed, as students must complete patient care documentation under their own login credentials.
