



Locum Opportunity – Urogynaecologist or Obstetrician Gynaecologist

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at Dalhousie University in Halifax, Nova Scotia, is seeking applications for a locum Urogynaecologist or Obstetrician/Gynaecologist with an interest in care of patients with urogynaecologic concerns. This position offers an exciting opportunity for academic clinicians to contribute to both patient care and education. The Department provides comprehensive OBGYN services to the Halifax region and sub-specialty care to the entire province of Nova Scotia. Clinicians also play an integral role in the education of medical students, residents, and allied health personnel.

The Division of Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery at Dalhousie consists of a collegial, interdisciplinary team who provide comprehensive medical and surgical subspecialist care to patients with pelvic floor disorders from across the Maritimes.

Position Details:

- **Location:** The successful candidate will be based within the Women's and Newborn Health Program at the IWK Health Centre. Clinics are located in Halifax and Dartmouth.
- **Timing/Duration:** June 1, 2026 to March 31, 2027 (there may be flexibility for both the start and end dates).
- **Reporting:** Physician report to the Department Head.
- **Responsibilities:**
 - Provide general obstetrics and gynecology care to residents of the Halifax region.
 - Provide urogynaecologic care in the scope of a generalist or sub-specialist (depending on level of training). Sub-specialist care responsibilities will be delegated based on qualifications and may include: consultation for patients with urogynaecologic concerns; interpretation of multi-channel urodynamics and cystoscopy; and urogynaecologic procedures and surgeries in both the outpatient procedure suite and main operating room.
 - Educate trainees at all levels (medical students, residents) and allied health personnel.

Qualifications:

- **Certifications:** FRCSC (or equivalent) in Obstetrics and Gynaecology. Fellowship in Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery is considered an asset for this role.
- **Licensure:** Eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Nova Scotia.
- **Skills:** Strong collaboration skills and an interest in education.

Compensation:

- Remuneration is provided through an AFP (Alternative Funding Plan) with a set rate for Monday to Friday work. Additional compensation will be provided for after-hours call responsibilities.
